

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§387-2 Minimum wages. (a) Except as provided in section 4 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 5 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 6 than: 7 (1) \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 8 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; 9 \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; (3) 10 (4)\$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 11 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 12 (6) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; [and] \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018 [-], and 13 (7) 14 ending on December 31, 2018; and An amount adjusted in accordance with subsection (c) 15 (8) 16 beginning January 1, 2019.

The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to 1 be increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less 2 3 than: 4 (1) 25 cents; 5 50 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2015; and 75 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2016, 6 (3) below the applicable minimum wage by the employee's employer and 7 8 the combined amount the employee receives from the employee's 9 employer and in tips is at least 50 cents more than the applicable minimum wage; provided that beginning January 1, 10 2015, the combined amount the employee receives from the 11 employee's employer and in tips is at least \$7.00 more than the 12 applicable minimum waqe. 13 (c) On September 30, 2018, and on September 30 each year 14 thereafter, the department of labor and industrial relations 15 shall calculate an adjusted minimum wage rate. The adjusted 16 minimum wage rate shall be calculated to the nearest cent using 17 the Honolulu region consumer price index for urban wage earners 18 and clerical workers, CPI-W, or a successor index, for the 19 twelve months prior to September 1 of each year as calculated by 20 the United States Department of Labor. Each adjusted minimum

- 2 the following January 1."
