
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2017-2018:

5 1. To be expended by the department of education:
6 A. Halau Ku Mana public charter school, Oahu
7 Plans, design, construction, and equipment to install
8 a permanent wastewater system, an additional fire
9 hydrant, and utility and infrastructure upgrades
10 including electrical services, outdoor site lighting,
11 and water distribution.
