
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTEENTH, FIFTEENTH, AND SIXTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE
DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$9,400,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2017-2018
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the fourteenth, fifteenth, and sixteenth representative
7 districts, as follows:

8 For the fourteenth district:

9 1. To be expended by the department of accounting and
10 general services:

11 Samuel Mahelona memorial
12 hospital asset analysis,
13 Kauai.
14 Feasibility and cost analysis
15 for the renovation or



1 rebuilding of Samuel Mahelona
2 memorial hospital.

5 2. To be expended by the department of land and natural
6 resources:

7 A. Waiakaea (Lihi) canal boat

15 B. Pua Loke plant nursery

6 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 8 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 9 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
 10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 12 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
 13 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
 14 this Act.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
