# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the University of  
2 Hawaii system is working towards eliminating the university's  
3 deferred maintenance backlog and modernizing facilities and  
4 campus environments to be safe, sustainable, and supportive of  
5 modern practices in teaching, learning, and research.

6           The legislature further finds that the university has a  
7 ten-year strategy plan to eliminate deferred maintenance and  
8 reach modernization goals, which includes implementing projects  
9 to reduce energy consumption and to generate renewable energy on  
10 campus.

11           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate general funds for  
12 project-funded staff positions for capital improvement program  
13 projects.

14           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$           or so much  
16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the  
17 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year



1 2018-2019 for the costs relating to wages and fringe benefits  
2 for permanent, project-funded staff positions that may also  
3 include funds for non-permanent positions for the implementation  
4 of capital improvement projects for the University of Hawaii.

5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University  
6 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
