A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there are
- 2 subdivisions that do not fit into the current definition of a
- 3 "planned community association", as used in the laws regarding
- 4 homeowners' associations. Accordingly, the homeowners'
- 5 associations in these subdivisions remain unregulated and lack
- 6 access to the cost-effective dispute resolution mechanisms
- 7 provided for planned community associations.
- 8 The legislature further finds that applying the planned
- 9 community associations laws to these subdivisions will allow the
- 10 subdivisions to be regulated and to have access to current
- 11 mediation processes.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to expand the definition of
- 13 "associations" under the planned community association law to
- 14 include certain homeowners' associations.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 421J-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending the definition of "association" to read as
- 17 follows:
