RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§291-24 Motorcycles [and], motor scooters, mopeds, and
4	motor vehicles; noisy mufflers; penalty. (a) Every motorcycle,
5	motor scooter, and moped moving under its own power on a public
6	highway shall at all times be equipped with a muffler [$\frac{in}{in}$
7	constant operation to prevent any excessive or unusual noise and
8	$\frac{1}{100}$ No muffler or exhaust system with which a motorcycle,
9	motor scooter, moped, or motor vehicle is equipped shall emit a
10	noise level greater than sixty decibels, unless the muffler or
11	exhaust system is the muffler or exhaust system originally
12	installed on the motorcycle, motor scooter, moped, or motor
13	vehicle. No such muffler or exhaust system shall be equipped
14	with a cutout, bypass, or similar device. [No-person-shall
15	modify the exhaust system of a motorcycle or a moped in a manner
16	which will amplify or increase the noise emitted by the motor of

1	such motorcycle or moped above that emitted by the muffler		
2	originally installed on the motorcycle or moped except]		
3	(b) Subsection (a) notwithstanding, a motorcycle, motor		
4	scooter, or moped that:		
5	(1) Has three wheels;		
6	(2) Is powered by an electric motor;		
7	(3) Has a full body enclosed cab; and		
8	(4) Has a seat belt assembly or a child restraint system		
9	for the driver and passenger;		
10	shall not be required to be equipped with a muffler.		
11	[(b)] <u>(c)</u> As used in this section[, "muffler"]:		
12	"Motor vehicle" shall have the same meaning as defined in		
13	section 291C-1.		
14	"Motorcycle", "motor scooter", and "moped" shall have the		
15	same meaning as defined in section 286-2.		
16	"Muffler" means a device consisting of a series of chambers		
17	or baffle plates, or other mechanical design, for the purpose of		
18	receiving exhaust gas from the engine of the motorcycle [Θr],		
19	motor scooter, moped, or motor vehicle, and being effective in		
20	reducing noise.

3	(1)	Required to equip the motorcycle, motor scooter,

7	(2)	Required to obtain a safety inspection to ensure

Report Title:

Motorcycles; Motor Scooters; Mopeds; Motor Vehicles; Noise Emission; Mufflers; Exhaust Systems

Description:

Prohibits the noise level of mufflers or exhaust systems on motorcycles, motor scooters, mopeds, and motor vehicles from emitting a noise level exceeding sixty decibels, with certain exceptions. Provides a graduated schedule of fines for first, second, and subsequent violations.
