## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSING.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 444-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 In addition to any other remedy available, the "(a) 4 investigator [may] shall issue citations to persons who the 5 investigator determines to be acting in the capacity of, or 6 engaging in the business of, a contractor within the State, without having a license to so act or engage previously obtained 7 8 under and in compliance with this chapter and the rules 9 promulgated thereunder. [If the investigator determines that a 10 person is acting in the capacity of, or engaging in the business 11 of, a contractor within this State without having a license to so act or engage, the investigator may issue a citation to such 12 13 person.] 14 Nothing in this section shall preclude the department from 15 pursuing available civil remedies such as court-ordered 16 injunctions and enhanced fines."

**Report Title:** Unlicensed Activity; Citation; Contractor

#### Description:

Requires an investigator to issue a citation to any person determined to be acting in the capacity of or engaging in the business of a contractor within the State without having a required license. Clarifies that DCCA may pursue available civil remedies such as court-ordered injunctions and enhanced fines. (HB378 HD1)
