
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BEACH MONITORING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2018-2019 for the two-year extension of the post-bypass beach
6 monitoring program of the Kikiaola small boat harbor sand bypass
7 operation at Waimea, Kauai.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
