# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 481B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§481B- Sales receipt required; cash purchases. (a) As  
5 used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:

6           "Merchant" means any person engaged in the business of  
7 offering services or goods for sale to customers at retail.

8           "Sales receipt" means any documentation that substantiates  
9 the sale of services or goods from a merchant.

10           (b) Unless specifically declined by the customer, a  
11 merchant shall provide a sales receipt to any customer paying  
12 for a good or service in cash.

13           (c) A sales receipt shall, at a minimum, contain:

14           (1) The name of the merchant;

15           (2) The transaction date;

16           (3) A detailed description of the goods or services  
17 purchased;

- 1        (4) The amount paid; and
- 2        (5) Information indicating that the form of payment was in
- 3        cash."

4        SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

5        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
