# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2017-2018:

5           1. To be expended by the department of accounting and  
6           general services:

7           A. Lyman Museum, Hawaii

8           Plans, design, construction, and equipment to replace  
9           the copper gutters and downspouts with stainless steel  
10           in the main museum building.
