A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR HIKER SAFETY AND PREPAREDNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that every year there are
- 2 numerous search and rescue efforts in Hawaii because hikers
- 3 choose to ignore government warnings or hike on unmarked trails.
- 4 The counties expend crucial resources including money, time, and
- 5 energy to save these hikers, and responders risk serious injury
- 6 and death. The legislature further finds that a public
- 7 awareness campaign to educate hikers would help reduce future
- 8 hiking incidents.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 10 department of land and natural resources for a public awareness
- 11 campaign to educate the public about hiker safety and
- 12 preparedness.
- 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for a
- 16 public awareness campaign to educate the public about hiker
