

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By amending its title to read:
- 4 "\$302A-706 [Teacher national] National board certification
- 5 incentive program."
- 6 2. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- 7 "(a) There is established within the department the
- 8 [teacher] national board certification incentive program to
- 9 recognize and support exemplary [teaching] educational practice
- 10 by supporting public school teachers and school psychologists
- 11 who have achieved national board certification under the
- 12 certification program of the National Board for Professional
- 13 Teaching Standards[-] or National Association of School
- 14 Psychologists. The [teacher] national board certification
- 15 incentive program shall provide:

17		(B)	A school with a high turnover rate, as determined
18			by the department; or
19		(C)	A hard-to-fill school, as determined by the
20			department[-]; and

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1	(5)	An additional \$ bonus per year for any
2		school psychologist employed at a public school who
3		received a yearly bonus pursuant to paragraph (4);
4		provided that the school psychologist maintains
5		national board certification and continues working in
6		the same school after the school no longer meets any
7		of the criteria under paragraph (4). The school
8		psychologist shall receive the additional bonus from
9		the time the school no longer meets any of the
10		criteria under paragraph (4) until the end date of the
11		school psychologist's national board certification in
12		effect at the time the school no longer meets those
13		criteria, or until the school psychologist is no
14		longer employed at the school, whichever occurs

Education; National Board Certification Incentive Program

Description:

Expands the National Board Certification Incentive Program to provide monetary incentives to school psychologists. Authorizes continuing bonuses for school psychologists in certain designated schools that improve and no longer carry a certain designation.

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
