## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many Hawaii
2	residents are becomingly increasingly concerned that there is
3	insufficient oversight of restricted use pesticides. Response
4	times to alleged restricted use pesticide violations are
5	unreasonably long, particularly on the island of Oahu. To
6	address public concerns, and in the interest of public health,
7	safety, and welfare, it is of utmost importance that there are a
8	sufficient number of agriculture positions to properly
9	administer and regulate restricted use pesticides in accordance
10	with the Hawaii pesticides law.
11	The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for one
12	additional chemist position and two additional case developer
13	positions on the island of Oahu within the department of
14	agriculture's pesticides branch.
15	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
16	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
