A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that diversifying the
- 2 economy is critical to the future of the State.
- 3 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish the
- 4 high-growth grant program within the department of business,
- 5 economic development, and tourism to assist qualified businesses
- 6 by providing grants for specific business development purposes.
- 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- ${f 9}$ designated and to read as follows:
- 10 "§201- High-growth grant program; high-growth grant
- 11 program special fund; established. (a) There is established
- 12 within the department a business development grant program that
- 13 shall be known as the high-growth grant program. The high-
- 14 growth grant program shall assist qualified businesses by
- 15 providing grants to:
- 16 (1) Expand business operations;
- 17 (2) Improve business productivity; or



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1	(3)	Invest	in	food	safety	or	quality	control	programs.

- 2 (b) The department shall issue grants under the high-
- 3 growth grant program to finance:
- 4 (1) Equipment purchases;
- 5 (2) Management and workforce training;
- 6 (3) Infrastructure improvements; and
- 7 (4) Consulting or feasibility studies.
- 8 (c) There is established in the state treasury the high-
- 9 growth grant program special fund to be administered by the
- 10 department of business, economic development, and tourism and
- 11 into which shall be deposited appropriations made by the
- 12 legislature to the fund. Moneys in the special fund shall be
- 13 used for the purposes of this section.
- 14 (d) The high-growth grant program shall provide grants to
- 15 qualified businesses in an amount no greater than forty per cent
- 16 of the amount that is privately invested in a business for one
- 17 or more of the purposes set forth in subsection (a); provided
- 18 that the program shall provide no more than \$400,000 to any
- 19 specific qualified business in one calendar year.
- 20 (e) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 21 91 to implement this section.



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(f) As used in this section, "qualified business" means a 1 2 business that has: (1) Been in business for at least two full years; and 3 (2) Demonstrated the ability to export products." 4 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the 7 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 8 2018-2019 to be deposited into the high-growth grant program 9 10 special fund. SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the high-growth 11 grant program special fund the sum of \$ or so much 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the 13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 14 2018-2019 for the high-growth grant program to provide grants to 15 qualified businesses; provided that no more than \$100,000 may be 16 used to administer the program in any fiscal year. 17 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 18 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes 19 20 of this Act.

SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.

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SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
