
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE AGING AND DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's aging
2 and disability resource center is a navigational tool intended
3 to streamline access to long-term supports and services for
4 older adults, individuals with disabilities, and family
5 caregivers. The legislature additionally finds that proper
6 funding for the aging and disability resource center is
7 essential to ensure the center is an effective single point of
8 entry for individuals seeking information about appropriate
9 long-term care options. Ensuring the availability of services
10 once a consumer receives a referral, such as those offered
11 through the kupuna care program, is also critical to the success
12 of the aging and disability resource center.

13 The legislature notes that funding for the aging and
14 disability resource center supports county area agencies on
15 aging and allows the agencies to operate aging and disability
16 resource centers within the counties. Funding for the aging and



1 disability resource center will be used for the ongoing
2 implementation of a fully functional statewide aging and
3 disability resource center network to serve as a single entry
4 point for access to public long-term support programs and
5 benefits.

6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
7 aging and disability resource center.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
11 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
12 2018-2019 for the aging and disability resource center.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
14 of health for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2075.
