# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The department of business, economic 2 development, and tourism is authorized to establish and fill one permanent state public-private partnership coordinator position, 3 4 exempt from the provisions of chapter 76, Hawaii Revised 5 Statutes, to be placed under the director of business, economic 6 development, and tourism to manage all public-private 7 partnerships entered into by the State and manage all contracts, 8 proposals, and negotiations associated with the State's public-9 private partnerships. Public-private partnerships entered into 10 by the Hawaii public housing authority are exempted from this 11 Act.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to establish and fill the state public-private partnership coordinator position to carry out the purposes of

1	this Act; provided that the position may be added to the
2	position count for the department of business, economic
3	development, and tourism.
4	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
5	of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
6	of this Act.
7	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2038.
