
RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-11.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 3 "(e) A person who fails to comply with the requirements of
- 4 this section shall be subject to a fine of [\$45] \$135 for each
- 5 violation, a surcharge of \$10 which shall be deposited into the
- 6 neurotrauma special fund, and may be subject to a surcharge of
- 7 up to \$10 which shall be deposited into the trauma system
- 8 special fund."
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
