Section 342G-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) In implementing this chapter, the department and each 4 county shall consider the following solid waste management 5 practices and processing methods in their order of priority: 6 Source reduction; (1) 7 Recycling and bioconversion, including composting; (2) 8 [and] 9 (3) Waste-to-energy; and 10 $[\frac{3}{3}]$ (4) Landfilling and incineration. 11 The respective roles of landfilling and incineration shall be 12 left to each county's discretion." 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2090.
