
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AERONAUTICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes the need to correct
2 the penalty for safety practices and licensing of individuals
3 engaged in commercial activities at public airports by amending
4 the provisions relating to penalties under chapter 261, Hawaii
5 Revised Statutes, to allow for either a criminal penalty or a
6 fine for the behavior and activities that do not threaten the
7 safety or operation of aircraft but violate the provisions of
8 chapter 261.

9 SECTION 2. Section 261-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

11 "(a) Except as provided in subsection (c), any person
12 [~~violating~~] who violates any provision of this chapter, or any
13 of the rules or orders issued pursuant thereto and relating to:

- 14 (1) Safety measures, practices, or requirements;
15 (2) Airport security measures or requirements; or
16 (3) The licensing and regulation of persons engaged in
17 commercial activities at public airports,

1 ~~[duly adopted or served,]~~ shall be guilty of a misdemeanor[-] or
2 shall be fined not more than \$200 for each violation."

3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
