# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds  
2 for the executive office on early learning to enter into  
3 contracts with third-party providers for family-child  
4 interaction learning programs that support families to take an  
5 active role in the social, emotional, and cognitive development  
6 of their young children.

7           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much  
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the  
10 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
11 2018-2019 for the executive office on early learning to enter  
12 into contracts with third party providers for family-child  
13 interaction learning programs that support families to take an  
14 active role in the social, emotional, and cognitive development  
15 of their young children.



1           The sums appropriated shall be expended by the executive  
2 office on early learning for the purposes of this Act.  
3           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
