# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CONTRACTORS LICENSE BOARD TO EITHER ELIMINATE OR  
RECLASSIFY INTERIM SPECIALTY LICENSE.

1           WHEREAS, the Contractors License Board (Board) has the  
2 authority to create and maintain contractor licenses for the  
3 State of Hawaii; and

4  
5           WHEREAS, the Board is required to follow the Hawaii Revised  
6 Statutes to change any rules; and

7  
8           WHEREAS, classifications under the C-68 classified  
9 specialist license may be issued before the work to be performed  
10 is defined and a hearing is held to establish the proper  
11 classification; and

12  
13           WHEREAS, the construction industry considers a C-68  
14 classified specialist license to be an interim specialty license  
15 until the license has been reviewed and defined through the  
16 process of a public hearing by the Board; and

17  
18           WHEREAS, the Board, after a hearing and based on  
19 established usage in the construction industry, may create,  
20 modify, or delete existing classifications; and

21  
22           WHEREAS, classifications under the C-68 classified  
23 specialist license have not been defined in definitions that  
24 have undergone the public hearing process, which would have  
25 provided the general public or other interested parties with the  
26 opportunity to review and comment on the definitions; now,  
27 therefore,

29           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
30 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session

4 of classification definitions; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board is requested to  
7 complete the review, modification, or incorporation of any or  
8 all of the C-68 classified specialist licenses or propose and  
9 adopt a new specialty license; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board is requested to  
12 complete this review prior to the next Regular Session of 2018;  
13 and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board is requested to  
16 transmit a report of its actions to the Legislature no later  
17 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session  
18 of 2018; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Director  
22 of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Chairperson of the Board of  
23 Electricians and Plumbers, and the Chairperson of the  
24 Contractors License Board.
