

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO RESTORE FREE AND FAIR ELECTIONS BY APPLYING FOR A CONVENTION TO PROPOSE AMENDMENTS TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, according to The Federalist No. 52 by James 1 2 Madison, the framers of the Constitution of the United States intended that the Congress of the United States should be 3 "dependent on the people alone"; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the "dependency on the people alone" has evolved 6 7 into a dependency on powerful special interests that act through 8 campaigns or third-party groups, thereby creating a fundamental 9 imbalance in our representative democracy; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Americans across the political spectrum agree that elections in the United States should be free from the 12 disproportional influence of special interests and fair enough 13 that any citizen can be elected into office; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution 16 requires Congress to convene a convention for proposing 17 amendments to the federal Constitution on the application of 18 19 two-thirds of the legislatures of the several states; and 20 WHEREAS, the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of 21 22 Hawaii perceives the need for a convention for the limited 23 purpose of restoring balance and integrity to our elections by 24 proposing a federal constitutional amendment to permanently protect free and fair elections in the United States by 25 26 addressing issues raised by the decision of the Supreme Court of the United States in Citizens United v. Federal Election 27 Commission, 558 U.S. 310 (2010), and related cases and events; 28 29 and

1 WHEREAS, the Twenty-ninth Legislature desires that currently elected state or local office holders shall be 2 appointed in equal numbers as the delegates to the Convention, 3 4 or alternatively, delegates shall be elected from each 5 Congressional district; provided that former or current federal 6 office holders, whether elected or appointed, are not eligible to serve as delegates to the Convention; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the Twenty-ninth Legislature shall retain the ability to restrict or expand the authority of its delegates 10 11 within the limits expressed herein; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the Twenty-ninth Legislature intends that this continuing application shall be considered with the applications 14 15 for a convention that have been adopted by the 2013-2014 Vermont Legislature, the 2013-2014 California Legislature, the Ninety-16 eighth Illinois General Assembly, the 2014-2015 New Jersey 17 18 Legislature, and the 2015-2016 Rhode Island Legislature, as well as all applications that are subsequently adopted until two-19 20 thirds of the several states have applied for, and Congress has 21 convened, a convention for proposing amendments to restore free 22 and fair elections; now, therefore, 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 24 25 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, the Senate concurring, that the people of the State of 26 27 Hawaii speaking through its Legislature, and pursuant to Article 28 V of the Constitution of the United States, hereby submit an 29 application to the United States Congress to call a convention for the sole purpose of proposing an amendment to the 30 Constitution of the United States that will restore free and 31 32 fair elections as described herein, as soon as two-thirds of the several states have applied for a convention for a similar 33 34 purpose; and 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 37 United States; Vice President of the United States, as presiding 38 39 officer of the United States Senate; President Pro Tempore of 40 the United States Senate; the Minority Leader of the United States Senate; the Speaker of the United States House of 41
