
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO
ESTABLISH THE REMNANT PARCEL TASK FORCE.

1 WHEREAS, the State owns numerous small pieces of property
2 that are commonly referred to as remnant parcels; and
3

4 WHEREAS, it may be to the State's advantage to sell some of
5 these remnant parcels; and
6

7 WHEREAS, creating a comprehensive inventory of public lands
8 that are remnant parcels and establishing a process for
9 evaluating their potential would assist in the disposition of
10 eligible remnant parcels; and
11

12 WHEREAS, establishing a working group under the House of
13 Representatives Committee on Water and Land would facilitate the
14 creation of a remnant parcel inventory and an evaluation
15 process; now, therefore,
16

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
18 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
19 of 2017, the Senate concurring, that the Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives is requested to establish the Remnant Parcel
21 Task Force under the House of Representatives Committee on Water
22 and Land; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force
25 is requested to include at least one representative of the
26 Department of Land and Natural Resources and one representative
27 of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force
30 is requested to create an inventory of remnant parcels owned by



1 the State that are suitable for sale, and to determine a process
2 for the disposition of suitable remnant parcels; and
3

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force
5 is requested to provide a report of its findings and
6 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
7 House of Representatives no later than twenty days prior to the
8 convening of the 2018 Regular Session; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
11 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of
12 Land and Natural Resources and the Chair of the Board of
13 Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.
