HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO ESTABLISH THE REMNANT PARCEL TASK FORCE.

1 WHEREAS, the State owns numerous small pieces of property that are commonly referred to as remnant parcels; and 2 3 WHEREAS, it may be to the State's advantage to sell some of 4 5 these remnant parcels; and 6 7 WHEREAS, creating a comprehensive inventory of public lands 8 that are remnant parcels and establishing a process for evaluating their potential would assist in the disposition of 9 eligible remnant parcels; and 10 11 WHEREAS, establishing a working group under the House of 12 Representatives Committee on Water and Land would facilitate the 13 creation of a remnant parcel inventory and an evaluation 14 process; now, therefore, 15 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 17 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 18 of 2017, that the Speaker of the House of Representatives is 19 requested to establish the Remnant Parcel Task Force under the 20 House of Representatives Committee on Land and Water; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force 23 24 is requested to include at least one representative of the 25 Department of Land and Natural Resources and one representative of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force 28 is requested to create an inventory of remnant parcels owned by 29 the State that are suitable for sale, and to determine a process 30 for the disposition of suitable remnant parcels; and 31 32

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force is requested to provide a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the House of Representatives no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2018 Regular Session; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 8 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 9 Land and Natural Resources and the Chief Executive Officer of 10 the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.
