HOUSE RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES AND DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO COLLABORATIVELY WORK WITH COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS TO IDENTIFY AND ESTABLISH OFF-LEASH DOG PARKS ON THE WINDWARD SIDE OF OAHU.

1 WHEREAS, according to the American Veterinary Medical Association, the national average for households owning at least 2 one dog is 36.5 percent; however, pet ownership on Oahu is much 3 higher, with at least 60 percent of household owning at least 4 5 one dog or cat; and 6 7 WHEREAS, off-leash parks are good for dogs, their quardians, and the whole community, as these parks provide 8 opportunities for physical and mental exercise, as well as 9 10 opportunities to develop and maintain social skills, for dogs and their owners; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, there are limited places to take dogs on the Windward side of Oahu, where there are six parks where only 14 leashed dogs are allowed; and 15 16 WHEREAS, there are only five off-leash dog parks on the 17 18 island of Oahu, none of which are on the Windward side of the island; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the Windward Dog Park Hui has been actively 21 22 searching for suitable places to establish off-leash dog parks 23 in their community; and 24 WHEREAS, off-leash dog parks, whether privately or publicly 25 owned, are maintained by volunteers and require users to pick up 26 after their dogs so that all park users can enjoy a clean and 27 safe environment; now, therefore, 28

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources and Department of Parks and Recreation of the City and County of Honolulu are encouraged to collaboratively work with community stakeholders to identify and establish off-leash dog parks on the Windward side of Oahu; and
