A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$59,116,610 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2017-2018
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 thirteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Central Middle School

8 A. Repaint the interior walls of
9 campus facilities; ground and site
10 improvements; and equipment and
11 appurtenances.

9 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
10 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
11 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
12 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
13 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
15 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
16 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

- 17 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 6 shall be
18 expended by the department of education;
- 19 (2) The sums appropriated in items 7 and 8 shall be
20 expended by the department of accounting and general
21 services;



1 (3) The sum appropriated in item 9 shall be expended by
2 the department of transportation; and

3 (4) The sums appropriated in items 10 and 11 shall be
4 expended by the board of education.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
