A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SEAWATER AIR CONDITIONING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$6,225,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2017-2018
5 for the purpose of designing and constructing seawater air
6 conditioning facilities for state buildings in downtown Honolulu
7 as follows:

8 Design, construction, and
9 equipment for seawater air
10 conditioning energy transfer
11 facilities for selected state
12 buildings in the Capitol District.

13 Project to include building and
14 site improvement, equipment and
15 appurtenances, and other project
16 costs.

17 Design \$468,000

4 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 5 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 6 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
 7 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 8 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
