 15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 16 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
 17 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
 18 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

19 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 20 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
 21 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:



- 1 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 to 12 shall be
2 expended by the department of education; and
3 (2) The sum appropriated in item 13 shall be expended by
4 the department of land and natural resources; and

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
