A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTY VEHICULAR TAXES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 200, Session
2 Laws of Hawaii 2016, relating to mopeds, did not include funding
3 for the counties to implement and enforce the new law, as
4 required by article VIII, section 5 of the Hawaii State
5 Constitution.

6 The purpose of this Act is to clarify that moneys may be
7 expended from the bikeway fund to pay the state's share of the
8 costs to the counties associated with issuing certificate of
9 inspection for mopeds.

10 SECTION 2. Section 249-17.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11 amended to read as follows:

12 "**§249-17.5 Bikeway fund; established.** All fees collected
13 under sections 249-14 and 249-14.5 shall be deposited in a fund
14 to be known as the "bikeway fund" and shall be expended in the
15 county in which the fees are collected for the following
16 purposes:
