A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
ELEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$31,339,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2017-2018
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the eleventh senatorial district, as follows:

7 To be expended by the department of education:

8 A. President Theodore Roosevelt high
9 school, Oahu.
10 Design, construction, and
11 equipment for a new gymnasium with
12 locker rooms, classrooms, and
13 other related facilities necessary
14 to provide equitable opportunities
15 for girls and boys; ground and

21 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.





2 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
3 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
4 this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
