# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
NINTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$60,600,900 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2017-2018  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the ninth  
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7       1. Aina Haina Elementary School, Oahu

13           SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
 14 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
 16 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
 17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

18           SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 19 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
 20 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

21           (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 9 shall be  
 22                   expended by the department of education; and



1           (2) The sums appropriated in items 10 and 11 shall be  
2           expended by the department of land and natural  
3           resources.

4           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
