# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAVEL AGENCIES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 468L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "§468L-2 Registration and renewal. (a) A travel agency  
4 shall register with the director prior to engaging in the  
5 business of selling or advertising to sell travel services.

6           (b) Each travel agency shall renew its registration on or  
7 before December 31 of each odd-numbered year. A statement on a  
8 form designed and provided by the department verifying that the  
9 practices of the travel agency are in accordance with section  
10 468L-5, shall be filed with the renewal.

11           (c) A travel agency that sells activities individually or  
12 as part of a tour package shall register with the director as an  
13 activity desk under section 468M-2.

14           (d) A travel agency that operates as a sole proprietorship  
15 shall file, with the initial registration or renewal, proof of  
16 professional liability and errors and omissions insurance in an  
17 amount of at least \_\_\_\_\_ dollars annually."
