A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "~~§6E-~~ President Barack Obama markers. (a) The
5 department shall place historical markers in the State to
6 indicate significant sites in the life of President Barack
7 Obama.

8 (b) The sites shall include but are not limited to Baskin-
9 Robbins on King Street, Island Snow, Kapiolani Medical Center
10 for Women and Children, Koko Crater Trail, Punahou Circle
11 Apartments, Punahou School, and Sandy Beach; provided that the
12 private businesses agree to have the marker placed at the
13 business or, if a private business does not agree, that the
14 marker shall be placed on public property nearest to the site."

15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.


