A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-1136, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~[+]§302A-1136[+] Enforcement. The department shall be~~
4 charged with the enforcement of sections 302A-1132 to 302A-1135.
5 ~~[Nothing in this section shall relieve any chief of police or~~
6 ~~police officer of the chief's or officer's responsibility for~~
7 ~~the enforcement of these sections, but their enforcement shall~~
8 ~~be subject to the plans and policies of the department.]"~~

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
