A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 to the department of health for the purchase of an ambulance
3 vehicle and the operational costs for one ambulance unit.
4 Operational costs include equipment, supplies, and personnel
5 costs for state-certified emergency medical services personnel.
6 This ambulance unit is to be a twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-
7 week service for the county of Kauai.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for the
11 purchase of an ambulance vehicle and the operational costs,
12 including equipment, supplies, and personnel costs for state-
13 certified emergency medical services personnel, for a twenty-
14 four-hour, seven-days-a-week, ambulance unit for the county of
15 Kauai.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
17 health for the purposes of this Act.
