A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRIVATE FLIGHT SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-424, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " ~~[+] §302A-424 []~~ Regulation or authorization of other
4 schools and classes. The department, at its discretion, may
5 regulate schools, classes, or courses excepted from the
6 definition of "private trade, vocational, or technical
7 school" ~~[-]~~; provided that the department shall authorize a
8 private flight school that:

- 9 (1) Is physically present in the State;
10 (2) Is certified by the Federal Aviation Administration;
11 (3) Offers an advanced certificate for flight instructors;
12 (4) Requests department authorization; and
13 (5) Meets any other requirements established by the
14 department by rule;

15 for the purposes of qualifying the flight school to participate
16 in loan programs established pursuant to Title IV of the Higher
17 Education Act of 1965, as amended."
