# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is important to  
2 be proactive about reproductive health to ensure that Hawaii's  
3 women and families are as healthy as possible. The legislature  
4 further finds that the One Key Question Initiative promotes  
5 reproductive health by encouraging all primary care providers to  
6 routinely ask women about their reproductive health needs by  
7 asking women the question: "Would you like to become pregnant  
8 in the next year?". This simple question helps prevent  
9 unintended pregnancies as well as prepare for healthy  
10 pregnancies.

11           The purpose of this Act is to fund a position for a one key  
12 question coordinator within the department of health.

13           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so much  
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the  
16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
17 2018-2019 to fund one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position




