S.B. NO. 762

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY REVIEW BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the small business
2 regulatory review board serves an important function in state
3 government by providing small business input into the rulemaking
4 process. The legislature further finds that the board's mission
5 is important for small businesses and Hawaii's economy.

6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
7 department of business, economic development, and tourism to
8 provide additional resources for the small business regulatory
9 review board.

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
14 2018-2019 for the department of business, economic development,
15 and tourism to provide additional resources for the small
16 business regulatory review board.




1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
3 of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
