BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 92-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

11	comparability among fees imposed by the State, or any other
12	purpose which it may deem necessary and reasonable; provided

Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2090.
