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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 378-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:
- 3           "~~§~~378-27 ~~[+]~~ **Exception.** Nothing in this part shall be  
4 deemed to:
- 5           (1) Repeal or affect any law or ordinance or government  
6 rule or regulation having the force and effect of law;
- 7           (2) Apply to lie detector tests administered by any law  
8 enforcement or corrections agency;
- 9           (3) Apply to the United States and any subdivision  
10 thereof;
- 11           (4) Conflict with or affect the application of security  
12 regulations in employment established by the United  
13 States or the State; or
- 14           (5) Apply to psychological tests administered by a law  
15 enforcement or corrections agency to determine the  
16 suitability of a candidate for employment with the law  
17 enforcement or corrections agency."



1 SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to any pending suitability  
2 assessments prior to the effective date of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
