
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND
TOURISM TO CREATE A PLAN TO DEVELOP THE WEST OAHU CREATIVE
LAB MEDIA/FILM STUDIO COMPLEX AND TO RELOCATE THE HAWAII
FILM STUDIO TO THE COMPLEX AND URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF
HAWAII BOARD OF REGENTS TO APPROVE A CERTAIN TRANSFER OF
LAND.

1 WHEREAS, Waianae High School offers the Searider Production
2 Program, which strives to create an integrated educational
3 approach to visual media and media industry, and creatively
4 converge stories, culture, and community; and

5
6 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii West Oahu offers a
7 bachelor's degree in creative media, which opens the door to
8 careers in graphic and web design, digital video production, and
9 other digital media outlets; and

10
11 WHEREAS, there are few opportunities in West Oahu for
12 graduates in creative media programs to become employed; and

13
14 WHEREAS, Act 124, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, the State's
15 supplemental budget, appropriated \$17,000,000 to the University
16 of Hawaii West Oahu, contingent upon approval by the Board of
17 Regents of the University of Hawaii by January 1, 2018, of the
18 transfer of 30 acres, but no more than 50 acres, to the High
19 Technology Development Corporation; and

21 WHEREAS, the High Technology Development Corporation
22 intends to establish the West Oahu Creative Lab Media/Film
23 Studio Complex upon receipt of the acreage referenced in Act
24 124, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016; and

26 WHEREAS, the West Oahu Creative Lab Media/Film Studio
27 Complex would act as a creative media and film studio developed
28 through public-private partnerships; and

2 WHEREAS, the establishment of the West Oahu Creative Lab
3 Media/Film Studio Complex would provide an ideal location for
4 the Hawaii Film Studio, which is currently located in Diamond
5 Head and is the only state-owned and state-operated film studio
6 in the country, provides a secure, air-conditioned shooting
7 environment within Honolulu and has served as the headquarters
8 for television shows and films such as Hawaii Five-0; Magnum,
9 P.I.; Lost; Fifty First Dates; The Rundown; and Blue Crush; and

11 WHEREAS, the West Oahu Creative Lab Media/Film Studio
12 Complex and the relocation of the Hawaii Film Studio to the
13 Complex would promote growth in the business of creative media
14 and film; attract international investments into the area; and,
15 most importantly, provide local graduates who studied film
16 programs in West Oahu an opportunity to obtain employment in
17 their field and to live, learn, work, and thrive in the
18 community; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth
21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, the
22 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
23 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism is urged to create a
24 plan to develop the West Oahu Creative Lab Media/Film Studio
25 Complex and to relocate the Hawaii Film Studio to the Complex;

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Hawaii Board
29 of Regents is urged to approve the transfer of at least 30
30 acres, but not more than 50 acres, to the High Technology
31 Development Corporation upon the development of the plan to
32 develop the West Oahu Creative Lab Media/Film Studio Complex and
33 to relocate the Hawaii Film Studio to the Complex; and

35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
36 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
37 Board of Regents at the University of Hawaii and the Director of
38 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism.
