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# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONSTRUCT A  
ROUNDBOUT AT THE INTERSECTION OF KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY AND  
KAHEKILI HIGHWAY IN KAHALU'U ON THE ISLAND OF OAHU.

1 WHEREAS, residents of the windward side of Oahu stretching  
2 from Kane'ohē to Kahalu'u and even to La'ie have complained for  
3 years about the rush-hour traffic congestion on Kahekili  
4 Highway; and  
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6 WHEREAS, the traffic congestion poses a risk for increased  
7 accidents, degrades the citizens' quality of life; and causes  
8 motorists to lose valuable time in their commute to and from  
9 work; and  
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11 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has jurisdiction  
12 over State highways such as Kahekili Highway and Kamehameha  
13 Highway; and  
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15 WHEREAS, studies have found that a type of intersection  
16 known as a roundabout can increase traffic safety, increase  
17 traffic capacity of a roadway, and decrease commute times; and  
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19 WHEREAS, the Department previously intended to install a  
20 roundabout at the intersection of Kamehameha Highway and  
21 Kahekili Highway in Kahalu'u on the island of Oahu, but had  
22 instead decided to implement an alternative proposal, which has  
23 since been continuously delayed; and  
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25 WHEREAS, in its current state, the intersection of  
26 Kamehameha Highway and Kahekili Highway in Kahalu'u on the island  
27 of Oahu poses a danger to both drivers and pedestrians; and
