SENATE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING APRIL 15 THROUGH APRIL 22, 2018, AS VOLUNTEER WEEK
IN THE STATE OF HAWAII.

1 WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week was first designated by an
2 Executive Order from President Richard Nixon in 1974 and the
3 week serves to recognize and encourage people to engage in their
4 community through volunteer service; and

6 WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week works to inspire, equip,
7 and mobilize people to take actions that can change the world;

10 WHEREAS, individuals and communities are at the center of
11 social change, discovering their power to make a difference; and

13 WHEREAS, during National Volunteer Week service projects
14 will be performed across America and volunteers will be
15 recognized for their commitment to service; and

17 WHEREAS, KANU Hawaii, a local non-profit organization, with
18 its more than 15,000 registered members, seeks to annualize
19 attention to this week of service for the purpose of growing
20 connections between volunteers and local businesses, local non-
21 profit organizations, and community organizations; and

23 WHEREAS, the giving of oneself in service to another
24 empowers the giver and the recipient, and experience teaches
25 that government by itself cannot solve all of the issues facing
26 the United States of America; and

28 WHEREAS, the United States of America volunteer force of
29 over 63,000,000 is a great treasure and those who volunteer play
30 a vital role in community and in the United State's future as a
31 caring and productive nation; and

33 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that this body proclaim the week
34 of April 15 through April 22, 2018, as Volunteer Week in the
35 State of Hawaii in conjunction with the observance of National
36 Volunteer Week; and
