begs leave to report as follows:

Your Committee has reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by the nominee and finds Vincent Barfield to possess the requisite qualifications to be nominated for reappointment to the Board of Trustees of the Employers' Retirement System.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the reappointment of Mr. Vincent Barfield from the Department of Budget and Finance, Employees' Retirement System, and four individuals.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Mr. Barfield's professional experience and background in banking, investment services, and retirement plans qualify him to be nominated for reappointment to the Board of Trustees of the Employers' Retirement System. Your Committee notes that Mr. Barfield is a Trust Services Group executive who oversees the fiduciary businesses at Bank of Hawaii and has served on the Board of Trustees of the Employers' Retirement System since 2011 as a member and as the chair of the Audit and Investment Committees.
