Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1110  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TIER II FILING FEES FOR  
REPORTING OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to increase the Hawaii  
Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act, Tier II filing  
fee from \$100 to \$200 to provide needed preparedness resources to  
Local Area Planning Committees.

The Department of Health and Par Hawaii testified in support  
of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2090, to  
facilitate further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,  
consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your  
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.  
1110, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second  
Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1110, H.D. 1, and  
be referred to your Committee on Public Safety.
