Your Committee on Public Safety, to which was referred H.B. No. 1129 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SPECIAL DUTY FOR DEPUTY SHERIFFS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require the Department of Public Safety to develop policy and procedures to govern the processing of requests from deputy sheriffs performing special duty and to establish a compensation schedule for deputy sheriffs performing special duty.

The Department of Public Safety and two concerned individuals supported this measure. A concerned individual opposed this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2009, to promote further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
