Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred H.B. No. 1258 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to define and establish licensing and registration requirements for autocycles.

The Department of Transportation, Street Bikers United Hawaii, and Polaris Industries supported this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Clarifying that no person shall operate an autocycle on a public street, road, or highway unless the person possesses a valid type 2 driver's license; and
- (2) Amending the definition of autocycle to mean a three-wheeled motor vehicle with non-straddle seating that is steered by something other than a handlebar and is certified by the manufacturer to comply with all applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards as of the date of manufacture.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
