The purpose of this measure is to establish an affordable housing goal of sixty-five thousand units by 2025.

A concerned individual supported this measure. Hawaii Construction Alliance offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Establishing a goal of 57,000 affordable housing units by 2025;
- (2) Repealing the measure on December 31, 2025; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Housing that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1372, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
