The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds for the Healthy Aging Partnership Program to further the Program's important role in improving the health and well-being of Hawaii's kupuna.

The City and County of Honolulu Department of Community Services, Maui County Office on Aging, AARP Hawaii, Hawaii Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association, Hawaii Family Caregiver Coalition, International Longshore and Warehouse Union Local 142, and several individuals testified in support of this measure. Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- (1) Amending the appropriation to an unspecified amount;
- (2) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2075, to facilitate further discussion; and
