Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 884, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SCHOOL IMPACT FEES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to exempt affordable housing units, affordable housing projects that qualify for general excise tax exemptions, additions to existing dwelling units, accessory dwelling units, and ohana dwelling units from school impact fee requirements.



The Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation, Hawaii State Teachers Association, and Pacific Resource Partnership submitted comments.
